### Action Plans on Strategies

#### Underage Drinking-

- **Responsible Beverage Service-**
  - Dewey's doesn't allow under anyone under 21 in business.
  - B & J's Pizza reports their policy is to be very diligent in monitoring the alcohol coolers and intervening. They only serve alcohol to parents.

**- Cheetah's reports they have a \$50 cover charge for under 21 patrons, in order to discourage young patrons.**

**-Alcohol Compliance**

**- Sobriety /traffic checkpoints**

**Prescription Drugs - No statistics to report about the drop boxes at this time.**

Feedback, Questions, and Answers:

-Dr. Kost suggested putting stickers on alcohol products in stores reminding the public no one under 21 is allowed to drink. He also suggested involving the council of judges, and stress the meetings could be changed to accommodate the judges schedules.

- Dr. Garza suggested that the stickers on alcohol produces be made the responsibility of the alcohol distributors.

-a suggestion was made that HEB and Walmart could have separate checkout lines for alcohol to closely monitor the selling of alcohol.

- Several members suggested inviting the distributors, bar owners, and stores to join the coalition in order to enhance a united effort.

- Ray Casares, TAMU reports viewing a powerful MIT video "Tell Me Something I don't Know," and feels it could be useful for coalition goals.

-Elvia reports Caller Times wants to do an interview with Donine to increase public awareness of the coalition.

- Daniel Rodriguez suggested using photos of a beer soaked liver, and how men get beer bellies, as a deterrent from alcohol.
