Review of Meeting Minutes/Review

Underage drinking:

The coalition is continuing to work on issues with underage drinking. Donine Schwartz informed coalition Liquid Town still has poster in the stores. Also working on law enforcement vehicles displaying "Seat Reserve" stickers. There Texas A&M will be having a town hall meeting on underage drinking in April of this year.

Prescription Drugs:

Our Coalition has a total of six boxes in Nueces and San Patricio Counties. Sheriff's Office in Sinton, Police Department in Robstown, Nueces County Sheriff's Office Corpus Christi, Constables Office in Port Aransas, Constables Office in Flour Bluff, and the Police Department in Portland. We are currently working on installing two more in the spring. National Take Back Day is April 30 and we need to come up with a way to spread the word. Some coalition members suggested that we make flyers and put them up pharmacy stores. The amounts collected at the Sheriff's office in Corpus Christi collected 8.8 kg, the Constables office in Port Aransas 38.4 kg, 6.2 kg, and N.A.S 93.5.

Marijuana:

The coalition is continuing to educate the public on the use of K2 in Corpus Christi. Donine Schwartz informed the coalition there will be a Parent Awareness Meeting on K2 to help decrease usage in Ingleside. There are a lot more overdoses on

K2 here at the hospitals. Donine shared with the coalition there is an issue with the homeless and K2 use. K2 is trending in other towns in the U.S with the youth using and are overdosing or dying from using it. On Tuesday 16, 2016 Del Mar addiction classes start. They will be part of our coalition soon and they want to bring awareness either before Spring Break or Drug week. They will want to do some type of awareness each month.
