Report on Committee Discussions

Dr. Kost also informed group of the recent 20/20 news program on Underage Drinking.
- Jesikah Gutierrez reports no contact with Ropers yet to inquire about their underage drinking policies
- Savanah Walker reports Clicks Paradise has measures in place to identify minors, and will ask minors to leave establishment if they suspect any non-compliance to rules.
- Sheryl McNary reports Texas Roadhouse also has policies in place to prevent underage drinking.

Donine has viewed the "Tell Me Something I Don't Know" video that Rey Casares suggested and is now in the process of purchasing the video.

Underage Drinking

Responsible Beverage Service – only 2 drinks served at a time to a person walking up to the bar.

Alcohol Compliance Check: No new developments.

Sobriety/ traffic checkpoints: Donine has attempted contact with DA Skurka, but has been unsuccessful.

Prescription Drugs – Donine Schwartz reported she has met with Chief of Portland Police, Gary Giles and is very interested in a drop box, but needs assistance from YCCC to obtain funds for the project. Capt. Cook explained that expenses are needed, not only the cost of the drop box, but the expense of meeting DEA specific regulations about the disposal and incineration of medications, along with the costs involved with personnel.

GUEST SPEAKER – Violeta Davila, PRC Evaluator for Region 11, provided information about her program, and how it can be utilized in the future.
