Underage Drinking –

Responsible Beverage Service – Discussed different approaches to environmental change.

Linda Benavides reports that the Trade Center has patrons walking throughout the center with alcoholic beverages, instead of staying in the establishment where they purchased the beverage.

Chelsea Craig reports that Chuck E Cheese has a policy that they only sell beer by the glass, instead of Peter Pipers practice of selling pitchers of beer.

Steve Hale Rockport Coalition reports they are doing environmental scans at stores. They ask permission of management and then go into the stores with a checklist. They focus on different facets of the selling environment, such as the height of open beer coolers, and proximity to the candy aisle that children would frequent. They are also trying to encourage placement of “counter posters” (anti use) next to the pro use commercial posters in the stores. Some examples of anti-use posters can be found at Project FACE website.

Alcohol Compliance Check - Increase the number of sting operations in Nueces County.

Sobriety/ traffic checkpoints: Continue to have discussions and brainstorm ideas on how to make blood draws more available than to tie up officers waiting at the hospital for extended periods.

Marijuana - Discussion to brainstorm on possible actions to decrease usage, such as ordinance to prohibit sales of paraphernalia supplies that are used with marijuana.-

Prescription Drugs – Plans are to continue to work on adding more drug drop off boxes, possibly in Calallen, Naval Air Station, and Texas A&M Corpus Christi.

Training: Capacity Training, Strategic Planning and Environmental –
More Strategic Planning training to be announced in future.
Texans Standing Tall continue to have Webinars online.

Donine reports the Party Dispersal Training went very well.
